At Plymouth House Nursery School, our primary focus is to establish a fun, engaging and positive environment for your child, making their first learning experience enjoyable. We strive to develop your child's social and communication skills and build the foundation for strong literacy skills. We want each child to leave Plymouth House with a strong sense of confidence and excitement for their next opportunity.

We believe that children learn best when they are encouraged to be active and creative explorers who can test new ideas and think independent thoughts. As such, our curriculum is play-based and flexible, allowing for the children's interests to lead the way. Teachers provide opportunities for the children to grow in all areas of development, including:

- » Social Development – making friends, feeling of belonging within a group
- » Emotional Development – sense of empathy, building self-confidence, practicing self-control
- » Cognitive Development – acquiring skills to solve problems, ask questions and express emotions
- » Physical Development – practicing fine motor skills, and strengthening muscles and coordination through gross motor activities

We provide enrichment programs which include music and movement classes. We are also fortunate to have a large playground for outdoor fun, as well as a large indoor space for those cold or rainy days!

Plymouth House encourages parent involvement and values the home-school connection. We have a *Mystery Reader Program* and are always looking for family members to come in and surprise our students with a favorite book. Throughout the year, we have various social events including a *Fall Pumpkin Walk* and a *Spring Fling*.

We offer between two-, three-, four- and five-day programs serving children ages 2-6 years old. - » Our hours may adjust annually depending on family needs (i.e., this year we close at 1:00pm on Mondays)

Enrollment Forms

To enroll your child at PHNS, the following forms and fees are required:

At Time of Application:

- Enrollment Application Form

At Time of Acceptance (February/March):

- \$125 Registration Fee
- Tuition Deposit to prepay for June of the coming school year (equal to one month of tuition)

Due August 1st:

Full packet of paperwork (to be requested through UpBup digital form software), which will include:

- Child's Face Sheet / Enrollment Form
- Authorization and Consent & Pick-Up and Release List
- Permission Form
- Transportation Plan
- Oral Health Agreement
- Developmental History
- Medical Forms
 - Annual Wellness Exam / Physical (current within the past year)
 - Proof of Lead Testing
 - Immunization Records
- If your child has Food Allergies, we require:
 - Individual Health Plan (IHP – EEC Required Form)
 - Food Allergy Action Plan (also called Anaphylaxis Action Plan)
 - All Medications that are listed on the above forms, which can include Epi-pen, Inhaler, and Antihistamine
 - All Medications must be in the **original packaging** with **prescription label attached**.
 - Medication Consent Form for each medication
- If your child has Asthma, we require:
 - Individual Health Plan (IHP – EEC Required Form)
 - Asthma Action Plan
 - All Medications that are listed on the above forms, which can include two different forms of Inhaler
 - All Medications must be in the **original packaging** with **prescription label attached**.
 - Medication Consent Form for each medication
- Additional Forms (i.e., Custody Agreements, Developmental Reports, etc.)
